2021 Contest Rules

1. The completed questionnaire entry form and all applicable fees must be submitted to the organizer by August 31, 2021, @ 2:00 p.m. The contest submissions can be mailed or hand delivered to Main Street Greenville, 504 Central Street, Greenville, MS 38701.
2. A Hot Tamale attire/costume/outfit, which may include ready-made clothing, is **REQUIRED** of contestants in the Miss Hot Tamale Queen division. Other divisions (Miss Washington County Hospitality excluded) may add corn shucks to their attire/costume/outfit for an additional 5 (five) points which will be added to the contestant's overall score. Corn shucks may be purchased at local grocery stores.

3. The attire/costume/outfit **must not** include a bikini or bathing suit. It must be modest and may include accessories such as a hat, gloves, or scarf. It may also include paintings, appliqués, paper, fabric or cardboard embellishments. Such embellishments must be handmade.
4. All contestants ages 13 - 24 will have a five-minute interview with the judges starting at **8:15 a.m.** the morning of the pageant. Contestants are required to wear white shorts, capris or pants, along with the provided 2021 Delta Hot Tamale t-shirt, for interview. Contestants in the Miss Washington County Hospitality Division are required to wear a suit or a dress.
5. Individuals competing in the Miss Hot Tamale division, as well as the Miss Washington County Hospitality division, will have an on-stage question. A walk through of the stage will be provided beforehand for all contestants.
6. Winners of the pageant will be presented on the Festival's Main Stage Saturday, October 16, 2021, as well as participate in the Festival Parade earlier that day. Winners must commit to community appearances during their reign. Such events include, but may not be limited to, Main Street Press Conferences and the Greenville Christmas Parade. In addition, the winners are expected to be ambassadors for the Delta Hot Tamale Festival, Greenville and Washington County. Winners must also commit to be present at the crowning of the 2022 Delta Hot Tamale Pageant. The details are to be mutually agreed upon by Hot Tamale pageant winners, Miss Washington County Hospitality winner and the Festival Committee.
7. The winner of Miss Washington County Hospitality must commit to represent Washington County in the Miss Mississippi Hospitality State Pageant in the summer of 2022. The state pageant is a week-long event held in Hattiesburg, MS.
