## Rules & Information for Planters Youth Partners Vendor

1. 20 PYP booths are available. All applicants must complete a brief financial education class offered by Planters Bank to help applicant succeed at the Hot Tamale Festival. Upon completion of class, applicant can submit application for Hot Tamale Festival. All youth booths will be located in the Planters Youth Partners area located between Planters Bank and First Methodist Church.
2. Electricity is not provided at booth.
3. **Vendors must furnish their own chairs, tents, decorations, etc.** Tents may be rented from GGDF for a fee (\$50.00 per tent-you must pay this fee) and are subject to availability. Rented tents are provided on a first come/first serve basis. GGDF staff will set-up and take down tents which are rented from us for this event. Please call 662-378-3121 x 302 for availability. This is an outdoor festival! Be prepared for any weather condition. It is strongly encouraged that each vendor has covering of some sort (i.e. tent). Vendors are further required to maintain a clean, safe and professional looking booth. Assigned spaces are final.
4. The Festival Vendor Committee will select PYP vendors based on the following:
  - A) Variety & quality of items sold.
  - B) Number of applications received.
  - C) Date that completed application is received with payment.
  - D) Any applicant must complete Planters Financial Literacy Course before submitting form.
5. Registration check-in is Sat., Oct. 16, 2021 from 6:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. (CST) at the entrance of the festival on Washington Avenue. **YOU MUST CHECK-IN BEFORE SETUP AND EARLY SETUP MUST BE PRE-APPROVED. Tent # badges must be visible at all times during the festival! Pictures that were mailed in will be returned in your registration packet.**
6. All booths must be set up by 8:30 a.m. (CST) Saturday morning and cars/trailers removed from the streets. Exhibitors must assume full responsibility for displays, sales and care of their items. Booth space must be left clean of any trash. **IF YOU SELL ALL MERCHANDISE BEFORE 4:00 p.m. , you may leave early, but cars/trailers are NOT allowed in festival area.**
7. Sales tax of 7% must be collected on all sales. Envelopes will be disbursed at check-in. Vendors may drop their envelopes off at the t-shirt tent at any time throughout the day located near the main stage. All vendors who do not comply with this requirement will not be allowed to participate in next year's festival. Tax numbers will not be accepted.
8. All applications are subject to the approval of the Festival Vendor Committee. The committee

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reserves the right to reject an application at their discretion. You will be notified of acceptance/rejection in a timely manner.

10. **Deadline to receive applications: 5:00 PM Friday, September 24, 2021.**

11. The Delta Hot Tamale Festival is a registered Trademark. Vendors are **NOT** allowed to sell items which portray or imply association with the Delta Hot Tamale Festival, nor any items which utilizes the Delta Hot Tamale name or logo.
12. The Delta Hot Tamale Festival is a family event. You will be expected to conduct yourself in an appropriate manner and comply with all the rules, regulations and laws of the City of Greenville, Mississippi. The Delta Hot Tamale Festival, through the Festival Director and/or authorized representatives, reserves the right to terminate the operation of a vendor at any time during the festival for any of the following reasons: Professional manner is not maintained by the Craft Vendor or his/her employee, Craft Vendor and/or employee commits any act detrimental to the purpose of the festival, Craft Vendor and/or employee fails to cooperate with event management staff, Craft Vendor and/or employee sells any product not listed on the approved list and/or Craft Vendor and/or employee sells food or beverages not otherwise approved on product list.
13. Vendors understand that this festival is an outdoor event and vulnerable to weather conditions. Vendors understand that fees are non-refundable due to acts of God, inclement weather, dangerous conditions, acts or threats of terrorism, natural disasters, or war.
14. **NO UNAUTHORIZED VENDORS & SOLICITATIONS ALLOWED. VIOLATORS OR ANYONE WHO FAILS TO ABIDE BY THE FESTIVAL RULES THAT ARE SET FORTH WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE FESTIVAL AND WILL NOT BE ABLE TO RETURN TO PARTICIPATE AS A VENDOR IN FUTURE EVENTS.**
